(04-034) ANNOUNCEMENT Regarding AWARD of QUESTYS SOFTWARE to the CITY CLERK for Use in Creating a PAPERLESS AGENDA and COUNCIL AGENDA PACKETS on the City's Web Site, AND CANCELLATION of the FEBRUARY 24, 2004, REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MEETING.

Council Member Turner announced that City Clerk Mary Haynes won a software package from Questys Solutions, valued at over \$33,000, which would give the City Council the ability of having a paperless agenda and having the ability for the Council Agenda Packet to be available on the City's web site. He said the prize would enable the City Clerk to reformat the document imaging program implemented several years ago, and this software package would enhance services in the City Clerk's Office. He explained as part of the change-over, the City Clerk's Office would receive training from the Questys' training staff the week of February 23, 2004, and had requested that the February 24, 2004, Council Meeting be canceled so that the City Clerk's Office could focus on their training that week.

She said the event was sponsored by ArtsPartners, PeoriaNext and a grant from the Community Foundation of Central Illinois. She urged Council Members and the public to attend.

EAST BLUFF UNITED NEIGHBORHOOD ASSOCIATION MEETING

Council Member Thetford said she attended the East Bluff United Neighborhood Association Meeting, along with the new City Manager, his wife and members of the City Staff. She thanked Interim Director of Planning and Growth Management Pat Landes for her work and her Staff's work in putting the meeting together. She said members of the POP team and the Police Chief had attended. She added that the meeting was a huge benefit to the neighborhood.

Council Member Sandberg said on Sunday, January 25, 2004, there was a house fire at Pierson Hills, located at the end of Nebraska Street and two young children were injured. He said this fire was in the general proximity of the Armstrong Fire Station and he requested a report back regarding the deployment status and the manner in which the fire was attacked, and what pieces of equipment would have been deployed prior to the recent change and transfer of fire fighting equipment.

Council Member Gulley reminded the Council and the public that a Town Hall Meeting would be held on Thursday, January 29, 2004, at the RiverWest Frank Campbell Community Center. He encouraged the Council and citizens in the First District to attend.

CITIZEN REQUESTS TO ADDRESS THE COUNCIL

(04-036) REQUEST from CITIZENS to Address the CITY COUNCIL Regarding VARIOUS ISSUES.

Hearing no objections, Mayor Ransburg granted Privilege of the Floor to those who wished to address the Council.

Ms. Levetta Ricca, 711 S. Greenlawn, requested assistance from the City Council regarding safety in her neighborhood. She discussed incidents which had occurred recently involving 20 to 25 teens fighting in the street and causing damage to property as they ran from the Police. She said in other incidents tires had been slashed on Greenlawn, Ann and Blaine Streets. She added, there had been theft of property, elderly neighbors had been threatened by these teens, and cars had been damaged. She said additional POP officers were needed and she requested that the new City Manager provide assistance to the neighborhood. She expressed concern that residents were planning to move out of the neighborhood or they would be taking matters into their own hands. She said the residents were trying to help make their neighborhood a safe place to live, but she indicated they could not do it alone.
