ACTION REQUESTED: DISCUSSION REGARDING GLEN OAK IMPACT ZONE TRAFFIC STUDY

At the March 10th City Council meeting, the City Council adopted an amendment to the Comprehensive Plan for the new Glen Oak School. The City Council was concerned with the possible impact that the new School and the closing of Frye Avenue would have on the neighborhood traffic. A report back concerning the traffic impact was requested. A study of the current conditions and possible results is underway.

The Traffic Commission has been asked to provide input and possible solutions concerning the potential impacts. A map of the area, with the available traffic counts, will be presented at the Traffic Commission meeting to assist the discussion.

9. Review Safe Walking Route maps and implementation plans
10. Review policy on residential parking permits
11. Review major road studies, like Pioneer Parkway Extension and Eagleview TIF study
12. Review new subdivision standards
13. Provide guidance on Neighborhood Traffic issues, as they arise
