

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING  
City of Peoria, Illinois  
Amendment to the 2008 HUD Annual Plan

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City of Peoria will hold a public hearing on Monday, April 27, 2009, at the Planning and Growth Management Department, 456 Fulton Street, Peoria, Illinois, in Room 402 at 5:30 p.m. to obtain comments regarding a proposed amendment to the 2008 HUD Annual Plan to create five new Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) activities funded by a grant from the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009. These CDBG activities are: ADA Ramps (Sidewalks), \$157,109; Glen Oak Impact Zone Sidewalks, \$200,000; Fire Station 3 Rehabilitation, \$25,000; Fire Station 8 Rehabilitation, \$80,000; and Center for the Prevention of Abuse Roof, \$54,400. The activities will be funded in the total amount of \$516,509.

This amendment will also create two new activities for the new Homelessness Prevention and Rapid Re-Housing Program grant from the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009. These are: Homelessness Prevention, \$750,884; and Administration, \$39,520. The activities will be funded in the total amount of \$790,404.
