Peoria Police Department Now Using the TracView System for On-Line Crash Report Access

The Peoria Police Department is now improving our level of service to our community by making crash reports available to the public on-line. Citizens, insurance companies, law firms, etc., are now able to rapidly find, view, and print crash reports from the comfort and convenience of their homes and offices. Reports will usually be available in this electronic format within 2 business days following the incident.

All crashes reported to the Peoria Police Department since September 1, 2009 are now available. Private citizens can access reports by visiting www.docview.us.com, clicking on **Private Citizen Purchase Crash Report**, and then following the simple instructions. A credit/debit card is required for this transaction and users will be charged a \$10 fee for each report. Commercial users may opt for monthly billing by clicking on **Request an Account**, entering the name of the organization, and submitting a completed request form. Account applicants will be notified by mail when the account is ready for use.
