**MINUTES****Motion:**

Commissioner Anderson motioned for approval of the minutes of the regularly scheduled Planning Commission Meeting held on June 15, 2011, as printed; seconded by Commissioner Breede.

Assistant Director Black encouraged Commissioners to call or email the respective presenters regarding their input.

**CITIZENS' OPPORTUNITY TO ADDRESS THE COMMISSION**

Roger Sparks, Peoria resident, spoke of the need for ADA bus stops to be included in the Comprehensive Plan and to be addressed. Assistant Director Black said bus stops would be included under transportation as mass transit.


