Mary Motteller, owner, presented an application for a Subclass 2 (live entertainment) License to be added to her Class A (tavern) with a Subclass 1A (2:00 a.m. closing) Liquor License at 802 W. Pioneer Parkway.

In discussion with Chairman McCabe, Ms. Motteller stated she was planning on having a two-piece ensemble and the hours of the entertainment would be from 9:00 p.m. until 1:00 a.m. on Thursday through Sunday. She explained that she was hoping to generate some Sunday business.

In further discussion, Ms. Motteller said that she had plenty of room in the front by the windows to put a single player or two-piece ensemble.

In discussion with Liquor Investigator Jordan, Ms. Motteller said that the house located behind her establishment was rented to the owners of the grocery store located where Jim's Steakhouse used to be. She added that she had given them a notice of this Public Hearing.

Hearing no further questions, Chairman McCabe called for the vote.

A motion was made by Commissioner White to approve the application for a Subclass 2 (live entertainment) license to be added to the existing Class A (tavern) with a Subclass 1A (2:00 a.m. closing) Liquor License at 802 Pioneer Parkway; seconded by Commissioner D. Turner.
