NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS

1. Time and Place of Opening Bids.

O'Brien Enterprises will receive sealed proposals for the improvement described herein at Mohr & Kerr Engineering, 7336 N. University, Peoria, Illinois, until 10:00 A.M. local time, Wednesday, March 14, 2012, and at that time publicly opened and read. A pre bid meeting will not be required.

2. Description of Work.

- (A) Proposed improvement is officially known as the **CAROLINE STREET IMPROVEMENTS.**
- (B) The work consists of furnishing and installing materials and labor to improve approximately 460 lineal feet of roadway of Caroline Street from Adams Street to Detweiller Marina. Improvements will consist of removal and replacement of sidewalk, curb and driveways. Bituminous surface removal and overlay, drainage, lighting, and other associated improvements.
- (C) O'Brien Enterprises will be directly contracting the work for the improvements as part of a development agreement with the City of Peoria. The City of Peoria will be reimbursing O'Brien Enterprises for the public improvements. All City provisions regarding EEO, prevailing wage, certified payroll, DBE and WBE requirements shall be strictly enforced.

3. Instruction to Bidders.

- (A) **Plans and proposal forms may be obtained from Mohr & Kerr Engineering & Land Surveying P.C., 7336 N. University, Peoria, Illinois, upon payment of \$25.00** for each set of documents obtained; said fee will not be refunded.
- (B) All proposals must be accompanied by a **proposal guaranty** as provided in Section 102 of the "Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction" and LRS 6 Recurring Special Provision, prepared by the Illinois Department of Transportation: a Bid Bond, or a proposal guarantee of cash, a Bank Cashier Check, or a properly certified check made payable to O'Brien Enterprises, for not less than five percent (5%) of the amount of the Base Bid.

4. Rejection of Bids.

O'Brien Enterprises reserves the right to reject any or all proposals as provided in Section 102 of the "Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction," and LRS 6 Recurring Special Provision, prepared by the Department of Transportation of the State of Illinois.
