

LEGAL NOTICE

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that sealed proposals will be received at the Office of the City Engineer, Public Works Facility, 3505 N. Dries Lane, Peoria, Illinois, until **11:00 A.M., Thursday, MARCH 22, 2012**, for the proposed project officially known as the **PENNSYLVANIA AVENUE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT (CALIFORNIA AVE. TO GLEN OAK AVE.)** at which time said proposals will be publicly opened and read.

The proposed work consists of improvements to the intersection, including a proposed roundabout, removing existing pavement, reconstruction and realignment of Pennsylvania Avenue, sidewalk, curb and gutter removal and replacement, storm sewer improvements, proposed roadway lighting, miscellaneous grading and shaping of earthen parkways, along with all necessary adjustments, incidentals and appurtenances. All work shall be in compliance with specifications and all state and federal laws and regulations.

Plans, proposal forms, and specifications for said proposed project may be examined at the Offices of the City Engineer, Public Works Facility, 3505 North Dries Lane, Peoria, IL. Before plans and specifications may be obtained, **contractors must be IDOT pre-qualified**. Complete sets of plans and proposal forms may be obtained upon payment of a fee of \$100.00 per set; said fee will not be refunded. All proposals must be accompanied by cash, certified check, cashier's check, or a bid bond for not less than five percent (5%) of the amount of the bid. The two low bidders must file, within 24 hours after the letting, an "Affidavit of Availability" Form BC 57 in triplicate. The successful bidder will be required to furnish a satisfactory Performance Bond for the full amount of the contract, with sureties, to be approved by the City Engineer. **Compliance with the Illinois Prevailing Wage Act is required under this contract.**

The City of Peoria reserves the right to waive technicalities and to reject any or all proposals.
